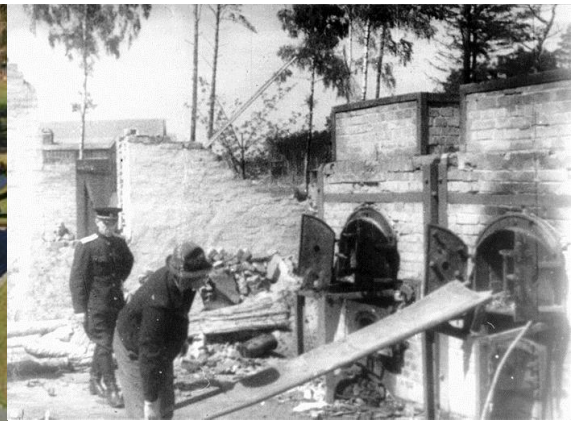

The next step of the tour will be visiting the former concentration camp Stutthof, where the Poles from Pomerania and the Jewish people from all over Europe were kept by the Germans.
